STUDENTS

This is your time to be free. Leave your troubles at the door. We will push you to be the best dancer possible. It is your responsibility to be at class each week and put in 100%. It is important to stretch and warm up before each class in order to reach your maximum potential. Bring your positive attitude and successful work dedication each week.

PARENTS

Your children's success depends on the support of their parents or guardians. We depend on you to be a great role model for your children, having a positive attitude and being dedicated to your child's dance education is very important and leaves a lasting impression on the children.

We are looking for support and dedication for your child, we support other students like a family.

Class Placement

The studio faculty will meet regularly to discuss the students' progress and/or placement. Placement decisions are from many years of teaching experience. Often a child is placed in a particular group or class where he or she will feel confident, in order to promote the development of self-esteem. If students are placed in the incorrect level and is too difficult, this causes a child to be discouraged. Others respond to the challenge of being in a class with students who are more proficient by pushing themselves to work harder. Do not compare your child to anyone else, each child develops at a different rate.

Weather Cancellations

Dress Code Requirements

All dress code requirements are listed on the website; all students must attend class in the correct attire.

Tuition

Tuition paid monthly(September-June). There are no adjustments for months with holidays. Tuition cannot be prorated due to absence. Tuition is due on the 1st of the month and is considered late after the 10th of each month. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged.

If you are enrolled join 2 classes the third class is half off.

Separation From the Parent

The process of separating from the parent as the child attends dance class is an important accomplishment of preschool children. As children mature, they begin to identify themselves as independent personalities. In separating from you, the parent, your child is learning

- · to develop an interest in the activities of the dance class;
- to feel comfortable with other children in the class;
- to understand that his/her parent will come back and pick him/her up;
- This period may occur anytime, but it is usually short-lived.
- · Here are some suggestions that might help you handle the situation:
- · Before you leave, see that the child is involved in an activity or is in the hands of a teacher. · Avoid any long goodbyes
- · Ask the teacher for help in separation. We expect them crying!

Attendance

Attendance is very important for you performer, please be sure your child attends classes regularly and is on time.

During the months of January through May, choreography for the recital will be taught and rehearsed. It is important for children to feel completely confident with the choreography and the year-end performance.

Illness

When your child has a fever, please keep him/her at home until the temperature returns to normal for 24 hours. If there are any lingering signs of illness, such as glassy or watery eyes, listlessness, and drowsiness, please keep your child at home. This will help to ensure that the illness has passed and that your child will be well enough to resume class activities the following week.

Tardiness

Dance is a physical activity that requires the body to be warmed up in order to execute movement safely. Please be sure to arrive at class on time and ready to perform.

Costumes

All Classes participating in the June Recital Costumes are \$75.00 for each costume and will be broken down into 2-4 payments, depending on the number of costumes per dancer. This does include tights.

Parking Lot Safety

Please be sure to enter the parking lot slowly. Do not allow your child to play in the parking lot.
